bread and cereal to enable our residents to make breakfast and between meals residents can make snacks for themselves in their apartments.

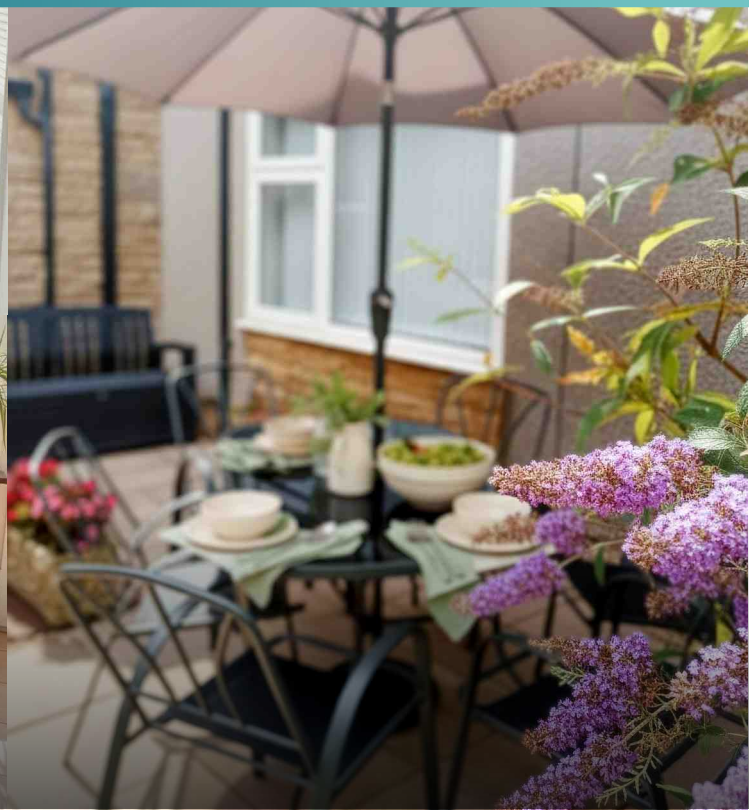
## Smoking
